- 02.** 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical) Mode.
- 2.** Heard Mr. Patra, learned counsel appearing for the Petitioner, Mr. Mohanty, learned counsel appearing for the Bank and Mr. Panda, learned counsel appearing for the Opposite Party No.1.
- 3.** The present Writ Petition has been filed *inter alia* with the following prayer: -

“Under the circumstances, the petitioner humbly prays that this Hon’ble Court may graciously be pleased to admit the writ petition, issue Rule nisi calling upon the Opposite Parties to show cause as to why;

1. A direction shall not be issued to the Opposite Parties to consider and dispose of the Petitioner’s Transfer Application dated 26/12/2025 on medical and disability grounds within a stipulated time frame.

ii. The Opposite Parties shall not be directed to post the Petitioner to his home district, Balasore @



Balasore Town, in accordance with the GoI Circular dated 20.02.2025 R/w DoPT Office Memorandum dated 2.2.2024. And, if the Opposite Parties fail to show cause, make the Rule absolute; and pass any other order(s) as this Hon'ble Court deems fit.

iii. Pass any such other order(s) or direction(s) as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the bona fide interest of justice."

4. Learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that through highlighting his grievance, the petitioner has filed a representation vide Annexure-2 to the Writ Petition, but till date nothing has been done in the matter. In such background, he prays that a direction be issued to the Opposite Party No.5 to take a decision on the above noted petition within a specific time period.

5. Considering the submissions made and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this Court directs the Opposite Party No.5 to take a decision on the above noted representation in accordance with law, within a period of six weeks from the date of production of certified copy of this order and communicate the result of such exercise to the petitioner.

6. The Writ Petition is disposed of accordingly.
