1. Heard Mr. Mohapatra, learned counsel for the Petitioner and Ms. Padhi, learned ASC for the State.
 2. The Petitioner has prayed for demarcation of a government road and eviction of unauthorized encroachers thereof. In the body of the writ petition sufficient cause of action in favour of the Petitioner is not disclosed and further, in absence of any demand/representation to the authority to discharge their statutory duty no writ of mandamus can be issued to opposite parties. The Petitioner though stated himself as one of the villagers but has not stated anything in the writ petition how his rights are affected by such action of the authority.
 3. Accordingly, the prayer is not entertained and the writ petition is dismissed.
