Considering the limited prayer of the Petitioner, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the Commissioner, Sambalpur Municipal Corporation, Sambalpur (Opposite Party No.5) to grant due opportunity of hearing to the Petitioner before proceeding for her eviction and take decision, in accordance with law, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order along with a copy of the writ petition. Till such decision is taken by Opposite Party No.5, the Petitioner may not be evicted from the shop room in question.
