1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and State.
2. Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 BNSS by the petitioner seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with Nuagaon P.S. Case No.264 of 2025 corresponding to G.R. Case No.421 of 2025 pending in the file of learned J.M.F.C., Patrapur on the grounds stated.
3. Perused the FIR as at Annexure-1. It is submitted that on the instructions of the petitioner, the co-accused, namely, Hrusikesh Patra brought the fire arm used during the incident, which was subsequently recovery and seized. The allegation is about organized crime and possession of fire arm. It is also informed to the Court that the above named accused is already granted bail. Mr. Panda, learned ASC for the state informs the Court that the petitioner has number of antecedents. Considering the above facts and submissions of learned counsel



for the respective parties and plea that the petitioner is not responsible for any such possession by the co-accused, this Court is inclined to direct him to surrender before the learned court below seeking release on the above plea advanced and in case of rejection, to approach the Sessions Court for orders.

4. Accordingly, it is ordered.

5. In the result, the ABLAPL is disposed of with the liberty in favour of the petitioner to surrender before the learned J.M.F.C., Patrapur within a fortnight from today and in the event, he moves an application for regular bail, it shall be entertained in connection with G.R. Case No.421 of 2025 corresponding to Nuagaon P.S. Case No.264 of 2025 and disposed of during the first hour and in case rejected, to approach the Sessions Court for orders on the same day considering the plea of parity and other claims and for that, the lower court record shall be made available at the time of hearing.
