1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/ Physical Mode).
2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner, the learned counsel for the Informant (Opposite Party No.2), the learned counsel for the Victim (Opposite Party No.3) as well as the learned Additional Government Advocate appearing for the State-Opposite Party.
3. The present CRLMC application has been filed by the learned counsel for the Petitioner under Section 528 of the BNSS, which corresponds to Section 482 of Cr.P.C. with a prayer for quashing of the entire criminal proceeding in C.T. Case No.177 of 2024 pending in the Court of learned NGN-Cum-J.M.F.C., Bhograi, which corresponds to Kamarda P.S. Case No.43 of 2024.
4. The learned counsel for the Petitioners at the outset contended



that the matter has been amicably settled and that the victim and informant do not want to proceed further in this case. He further submitted that in the meantime, the victim has already married to the Petitioner and they are staying together as husband and wife, in the meantime, they have also been blessed with a child. A joint affidavit has been filed by the Petitioner, victim and informant before this Court. Copy thereof has already been served on the learned counsel for the State.

5. On the request of the learned counsel appearing for the State-Opposite Party, he is granted two weeks' time to obtain instruction with regard to the genuineness of such affidavit and the contents thereof. In the meantime, the learned counsel appearing for the State-Opposite Party shall also obtain case diary as well as the statement of the victim, if any, recorded under Section 164 Cr.P.C. corresponds to 183 BNSS. In the meantime, the victim though her counsel shall approach the learned Public Prosecutor for recording of her statement under Section 164 Cr.P.C. corresponds to 183 BNSS along with the copy of the today's order. On such production of copy of the today's order, the concerned Public Prosecutor shall take necessary steps to record the statement of the victim under Section 164 Cr.P.C. corresponds to 183 BNSS. A copy of such statement be forwarded to this court by the next date.

6. List this matter on in the week commencing 17th August, 2026.

7. Interim order passed earlier shall continue till the next date.
