Behera, learned counsel for the petitioner contended that pursuant to the tender call notice issued by the authority, the petitioner participated in the process of tender and became L-1. But, instead of awarding the work in its favour, without assigning any reason, the bid has been cancelled by the authority, vide order dated 28.02.2024 under Annexure-4. Therefore, the petitioner has approached this Court by filing the present writ petition.
