1. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner through virtual mode from Court at Kalahandi drew attention of this Court to certified copy issued on 25<sup>th</sup> December, 2022 (Annexure-5) which contained following order of the Collector, Kalahandi passed in Settlement Revision Petition No.148 of 2020 filed under Section 15 of the Odisha Survey and Settlement Act, 1958:

*“This revision case has been filed by the petitioner U/s 15b of the OSS Act, 1958 for correction of the ROR. Register the case. Due to pendency of year old cases, the case would be taken up for hearing and admission considering the nature and serial number of the revision petition put up accordingly.”*

1.1. He asserted that the concerned authority has taken up the cases filed subsequent the above revision petition preferred by the



petitioner and disposed of. Hence, the petitioner has approached this Court with the following prayer(s):

*And may further be pleased to pass any other order (s), as deemed fit and proper in the interest of justice, equity and good conscience.*

*And for this act of kindness the petitioner as in duty bound shall ever pray.”*
