1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and State.
2. Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 BNSS by the petitioner seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with Badasahi P.S. Case No.427 of 2025 corresponding to C.T. Case No.1403 of 2025 pending in the file of learned J.M.F.C., Betnoti on the grounds stated.
3. Perused the FIR as at Annexure-1. The name of the petitioner is mentioned in the FIR alleging therein that he submitted false documents for reimbursement of medical bills for an amount of Rs.60,000/-. Mr. Mohapatra, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the reimbursement has not taken place and the petitioner has not received any such amount as a result. Recorded the objection of the State. Considering the allegation in the FIR and the above claim and absence of any similar antecedent as claimed, this Court is inclined to direct the petitioner to surrender before the learned court below for



being released with conditions even though his bail plea is not entertained.

4. Accordingly, it is ordered.

5. In the result, the ABLAPL is disposed of with the direction as aforesaid. It is further directed that in the event, the petitioner surrenders before the learned J.M.F.C., Betnoti in connection with C.T. Case No.1403 of 2025 corresponding to Badasahi P.S. Case No.427 of 2025 within a fortnight from today, he shall be released on bail on furnishing a bail bond of Rs.30,000/-(rupees thirty thousand) with one solvent surety for the like amount with such other conditions imposed and subject to confirmation with regard to the claim that he has not received any amount towards the alleged reimbursement. The above order shall also be subject to absence of any other antecedent of similar nature against the petitioner as further directed.
