I.A. No.536 of 2025

1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid mode.
2. This I.A. has been filed seeking modification of order dated 20.11.2024 passed in I.A. No.959 of 2024.
3. Learned counsel for the Petitioner at the outset contended that the Petitioner who is a very poor person is unable to take care of his health. He further contended that although the Petitioner has been advised to undergo Heart Surgery, however, due to the stringent



conditions imposed by this Court he is unable to undergo such surgery. Learned counsel for the Petitioner at this juncture further specifically raised objection with Condition No.IV of Para-15 and submitted that the Petitioner is unable to bear the expenses of the accompanying police personnel as has been directed by this Court. He further stated that the Petitioner is ready and willing to undergo such surgery if the same is available at any hospital in Bhubaneswar.

4. In such view of the matter, order dated 20.11.2024 is modified to the extent that in the event the Petitioner approaches the Court in seisin over the matter with a prayer to undergo the surgery at any hospital in Bhubaneswar, then necessary orders be passed by the Court in seisin over the matter facilitate the Petitioner to undergo such surgery within the framework of order dated 20.11.2024.

5. With the aforesaid observation and liberty to the Court in seisin over the matter, the I.A. stands disposed of.
