1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical Mode).
2. This is an application by the petitioner for grant of interim bail on the ground of his illness.
3. Heard, Mr. Rajesh Tripathy, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. Anil Kumar Nayak, learned counsel for the OPID in the matter and perused the record including the written instruction of the Doctor as produced by Mr. Nayak.
4. The Doctor in his report to Medical Superintendent, SCB Medical College and Hospital, Cuttack vide letter number 612 dated 26.11.2025 confirms "the Petitioner was admitted again on 15.09.2025 after referral from CTVS Department for fresh CAG. The same procedure was done on 19.09.2025 which showed multivessel coronary artery disease which requires CABG(coronary artery bypass graft)."



5. In view of the above facts, since the petitioner is suffering from some cardiac ailments, this Court by keeping the regular bail application pending, grants interim bail to the petitioner purely on humanitarian ground for a period of 45(Forty Five) days with effect from the date of his actual release on bail on such terms and conditions as deem fit and proper by the learned Court in seisin of the case, but subject to condition that the Petitioner must produce document sharing progress in treatment to the Court in seisin of the matter on every 15 days through his counsel, who shall supply a copy of it to the learned State Counsel.

6. The petitioner is, however, advised to surrender to custody after expiry of the interim bail, failing which the Court in seisin of the case may take coercive steps to recommit the petitioner to jail custody.

7. Hence, the IA stands disposed of. Issue urgent certified copy of this order as per Rules.

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8. List this matter on 22.12.2025. Learned counsel for the OPID shall produce the progress report on that date so as to evaluate the health condition of the Petitioner. Needless to say that all the medical documents which was obtained by the jail authority during treatment be supplied to the Petitioner by retaining copy of such.
