1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical Mode).
2. Mr.J.P.Patra, learned counsel for the OPID produces the written instruction received from the IO enclosing the opinion of the Dr.Madhukar Shahi of Narayan Hospital, Delhi NCR, which is taken on record, but Mr.Rajesh Tripathy, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that since the operation date of the petitioner has been fixed to 20th February, 2026, the matter may kindly be taken up thereafter so that he can inform this Court about the procedure adopted for surgery of the petitioner and the period of rest required by way of an affidavit of the near relative of the petitioner. Further, the IO in his report has stated that the report of Medanta Hospital, New-Delhi is still awaited.

In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstance and taking into account the submission as advanced for the petitioner regarding his surgery on 20th February, 2026, this Court considers it proper to take up the application of the petitioner after 20th February, 2026 and requests the learned counsel for the petitioner to apprise the Court the information as directed. Since the petitioner is on interim bail, as an interim measure, no coercive action shall be taken against the petitioner till next date. Accordingly, list this matter on 27th February, 2026.
