1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical Mode).
2. Ms.Chandana Tripathy, learned counsel who had appeared for the petitioner on the last date is not present, but Ms.Soumya Mishra, learned counsel submits that Ms.Chandana Tripathy is unwell and, therefore, the matter may kindly be adjourned. It is, however, found from the record that the Apex Court vide order dated 28.04.2026 in Special Leave to Appeal (Crl. No. 6629 of 2026) has requested this Court to decide the main bail prayer of the petitioner within two weeks from the date of copy of this order is placed before this Court while refusing to interfere with the order passed by this Court in rejecting the extension of interim bail prayer of the petitioner. Ms.Soumya Mishra, however, further submits that the



petitioner has surrendered to custody on 24.03.2026, but she has not produced any surrender certificate.

In this situation, especially when adjournment is sought for by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the learned OPID counsel is hereby requested to take instruction as to whether the petitioner has surrendered to custody or not. Accordingly, list this matter on 05.05.2026 as a last chance to the petitioner.
