**1.** Mr. Daksheswar Darshan Nayak, learned counsel on behalf of Mr. S.K.Panda, learned counsel for the petitioner.

**2.** The petitioner in the present petition has prayed for quashing of the judgment dated 10.06.2022 passed by the learned Judge, Family Court, Berhampur in Criminal Proceeding No. 73 of 2018. By the said judgment the petition filed under section 125, Cr.P.C. (since repealed and substituted by pari materia provision contained under section 144 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023) filed by the wife in the marriage and the child then a minor, was allowed. However, instead of ₹10,000/- for the wife as sought for, ₹8,000/- per month was granted and the child was granted ₹5,000/- per month towards maintenance.



3. The matter was presented on 22.07.2022 before this Court. It was listed before the D.R.(Judicial), Lawazima for removal of defects on 24.10.2025 and three weeks time was granted. Thereafter on 15.01.2026 it was listed before this Court and seven days time was sought for by the learned counsel for the petitioner to remove the defect.

4. Today the matter being in the list, is mentioned by the learned counsel for the petitioner and memo of date is filed which states thus :

*“As per the instructions, this matter may humbly be permitted to be withdrawn.”*

The memo shall be taken on record. Scanned copy be updated.

5. Accordingly the petition stands disposed of.

Copy of the order shall be forwarded to the learned Judge, Family Court, Berhampur, Ganjam to be kept in the records of Cr.P. No. 73 of 2018.
