- 01.** 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical) Mode.
- 2.** Heard learned counsel for the parties.
- 3.** While assailing the impugned order of transfer so issued under Annexure-3, learned counsel for the petitioner contended that since petitioner's husband is working as a Havildar and posted at Baripada Fire Station, petitioner could not have been transferred and posted by way of allotment made vide the impugned order dated 26.06.2026 to Rairangpur.
- 3.1.** It is also contended that petitioner since is a pregnant lady and she has been advised not to move, the impugned order of allotment will cause prejudice to her as well as to the foetus.



4. Learned Addl. Govt. Advocate is directed to obtain instruction as to whether petitioner's husband can be given a posting at Rairangpur along with the petitioner from the competent authority.
