01. 1. The Writ Application has been filed in substance making a grievance that in spite of the order passed by this Court dated 17.12.2024 more particularly Paragraph-8 thereof which is extracted hereunder for convenience of reference, the directions contained therein have not been complied with:-

"In the result, the writ petition stands disposed of with the direction as aforesaid to be complied with by opposite party Nos.2 and 3 in terms of Annexure-1 with regard to the construction work vis-a-vis work orders as per Annexure-3 series with a decision in that regard as soon as possible preferably within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order and till such time, the construction work in respect of the



Kalamatia Gram Panchayat and Anganwadi Centre to be kept in abeyance.”

2. Taking into account the submission of the learned counsel for the Petitioner that the inaction on the part of the Collector (Opposite Party No.2) is creating hindrance in the progress of the developmental work, learned counsel for the State is requested to obtain instructions in the matter.
