1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical Mode).
2. Mr. Devi Prasad Dhal, learned Sr. Counsel, who is being assisted by Mr. Koustuva Mohanty, learned counsel for the appellants submits that in addition to merit for grant of bail to the appellants, they also seek bail for their illegal detention beyond 24 hours for their arrest and for violation of not informing grounds of arrest to each of the appellants.
3. On the other hand Mr. Sarat Kumar Jena, learned counsel for the informant-cum-one of the



injured submits that there are two other injured persons namely Pintu Singh, Rahul Mugurai and the dependent of the deceased namely Badal Tandi who are required to be informed in view of the proviso appended to Sec.15-A(5) of SC & ST (PoA) Act, 1989.

Accordingly, the learned State counsel is requested to inform these victims and he is also requested obtain information by way of an affidavit of the IO regarding the communication of grounds of arrest to the each of the appellants and the time of arrest and time forwarding such appellants by next date. A copy of the brief be supplied to Mr. Sarat Kumar Jena, learned counsel for informant.
