1. Heard learned counsel for the respective parties.
2. Instant CRLMP is filed by the petitioner for a direction to opposite party No.3 in particular to register a case on the FIR and to take action against the accused persons in the interest of justice and according to law.
3. A copy of the complaint dated 28th May, 2026 is at Annexure-1. Mr. Biswal, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that even after such complaint, no case has been registered. It is further submitted that the petitioner approached opposite party No.2 with a report as per Annexure-2 but no result has been achieved. Recorded the response of the State. Since the limited grievance of the petitioner is for registration of a case on the basis of the report lodged as per Annexure-1, this Court, recording the submission of Mr. Mohanty, learned



ASC for the State, is inclined to direct opposite party No.3 to entertain such report and to take action in accordance with law without further delay as in the meantime a month has elapsed.

4. Accordingly, it is ordered.

5. In the result, the CRLMP stands disposed of with the direction as aforesaid. It is further directed that the report at Annexure-2 shall be treated as the FIR and in case, cognizable offences found to have committed to register a case and to take up the investigation forthwith by opposite party No.3.

6. Urgent copy of this order be issued as per rules.

7. A copy of the above order be handed over to Mr. Mohanty, learned ASC for the State for intimation to opposite party No.3 for early compliance.
