- 01. 1.** Flagging inaction of the opposite party No.3-Principal, Government Autonomous College, Angul in not permitting the institution of the petitioner to undertake fresh admission in Master of Business Administration course on self-financing under Public Private Partnership (PPP) Mode for the academic session 2026-27, the petitioner has come up before this Court to show indulgence invoking provisions under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India.



- 2.** Mr. Prafulla Kumar Rath, learned Senior Advocate appearing for the petitioner submitted that the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) extended the approval of MBA courses in respect of Government Autonomous College, Angul for academic session 2026-27. He further submitted that as the tenure of Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) had already been lapsed, the petitioner earlier approached this Court by way of filing writ petition, *i.e.*, WP(C) No.4790 of 2026 with a prayer for permitting the concerned authority to execute MoU with petitioner's institution for providing MBA courses from academic session 2025-26, which was disposed of *vide* order dated 30th March, 2026 with a direction to consider the representation. While the said representation is pending consideration, by way of SoP taking admission into MBA course self-financing courses under PPP mode has been restrained. Therefore, this matter requires consideration.
- 3.** Issue notice to the opposite parties.
- 4.** Mr. Debaraj Mohanty, learned Additional Government Advocate appears and waives issue of notice on behalf of opposite party nos.1 and 2.
- 5.** Issue notice to the opposite party No.3-Principal, Government Autonomous College, Angul by Speed Post with A.D., requisites for which shall be filed within three working days. In the event of furnishing such requisites



within the period stipulated, Office shall send notice to the said opposite party by fixing a short returnable date.

- 6.** List this matter on 17th August, 2026.
