1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned counsel for the State as well as the private contemnor represented by Mr. Amitav Tripathy.
3. It is stated by the learned counsel for the Opposite Party-Contemnor that the State-Opposite Party has preferred a Writ Appeal No.1437 of 2025. However she was unable to produce any order staying the further proceeding in the contempt application.
4. In the aforesaid development and on the request of the learned counsel for the Contemnor-Opposite Party, she is granted further four weeks' time to take steps for early listing of the writ



appeal and to obtain an interim order.

5. Learned counsel for the Opposite Party-Contemnor shall also take instruction as to whether the order can be implemented awaiting the final order likely to be passed in the Writ Appeal. It is further made clear that in the event, the order remains unimplemented and the Opposite Party-Contemnor fails to produce any order staying the further proceeding in the contempt application, this Court shall proceed with the contempt application and pass necessary orders in accordance with law.
