1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner as well as learned counsel for the accused. Mr.Nayak, learned counsel for the O.P.I.D. Perused the CRLMC Application as well as the prayer made therein.
3. The present CRLMC application has been filed with a prayer to quash the entire criminal proceeding in C.T.Case No.25 of 2015 arising out of Capital P.S.Case No.235 of 2015 pending before the Presiding Officer, Designated Court under section OPID Act, Cuttack.
4. Mr. Patnaik, learned counsel for the informant-Petitioner at the outset contended that due to misunderstanding the aforesaid case was registered at the instance of the informant. In the meantime, the Petitioner has received back money from the company pursuant to an



order passed by the Committee constituted under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble Mr. Justice Talukdar.

5. Learned counsel for the informant-petitioner contended that the informant has subsisting grievance against the Opposite Party No.2, who is the Petitioner in CRLMC No.1663 of 2025. As such he contended that the informant has no grievance in the present case.

6. Mr.Nayak, learned counsel appearing for the OPID contended that since the criminal proceeding involves several depositors, he is to take instruction in the matter.

7. Considering such submission, learned counsel for the O.P.I.D. is granted four weeks' time to obtain specific instruction and file affidavit by the next date with regard to number of cases filed and the amount outstanding and as to whether any money has been paid to the depositors pursuant to the decision of the Committee presided over by the Hon'ble Mr.Justice Talukdar.
