1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid mode.
 2. Heard Mr. M. Kanungo, learned senior counsel for the Petitioners as well as learned counsel for the State.
 3. Learned senior counsel for the Petitioners at the outset contended that on the basis of the narration of fact in the charge sheet no case under Section 137(2) of BNS is made out against the Petitioners. He further submitted that at no point of time, it has been stated in the entire narration that the accused-Petitioners ever kidnap the Victim.
 4. Learned counsel for the State on the other hand emphatically argued that there are ample materials to make out a case under



Section 137(2) of BNS against the present Petitioners. However, the submission of the State counsel is not convincing.

5. On the prayer of learned counsel for the State, he is granted further time to re-examine the matter.
