1. This matter is taken up through hybrid arrangement.
2. Heard.
3. This application under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been filed to quash the F.I.R. in Badambadi P.S. Case No.332 of 2024 corresponding to G.R. Case No.736 of 2024 pending in the court of learned J.M.F.C.(C), Cuttack.
4. Having heard from both the sides and upon perusal of the material on records, there appears no ground at this stage to interfere with the F.I.R. which prima facie makes out commission of the alleged offences. Hence, the application for quashing of the



F.I.R. is rejected. However, the Petitioners can file an appropriate petition before the trial court for getting discharge of the offences.

5. Accordingly, the CRLMC is dismissed.
