- 03.** 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical) Mode.
2. Heard learned counsel appearing for the Parties.
3. On instruction, learned counsel appearing for the TPCODL contended that since against the provisional assessment order, no objection has yet been filed, the writ at its present stage is not maintainable.
4. Learned counsel appearing for the Petitioner however contended that he be granted liberty to file an objection to the provisional assessment order so issued under Annexure-2-Series before Opposite Party No.2.
5. Having heard learned counsel appearing for the Parties and considering the submissions made, this Court while disposing the Writ Petition permits the Petitioner to

file their objection to the provisional assessment order issued under Annexure-2-Series as expeditiously as possible preferably by 31st July, 2026. On filing of the objection, Opposite Party No.2 shall take a lawful decision on the issue involved by giving an opportunity of hearing to the Petitioner.

6. Since it is contended that no disconnection has yet been made, the same shall continue till a decision is taken as directed hereinabove.

7. Accordingly, the Writ Petition stands disposed of.
