01. 1. Heard learned counsel for the Parties.
2. By means of this Application, the Petitioner seeks the following prayer:-

“It is, therefore, humbly, prayed that Your Lordships would be graciously pleased to admit the Writ Petition, issue notice to the opposite parties, call for the L.C.R. and after hearing the counsel for the parties, direct the Opposite Party No.3 to register the Sale Deed, if presented by the petitioner;”

3. Learned AGA, Mr. Jee, has no serious objection to the prayer of the Petitioner, if a direction is given to the Sub-Registrar to act in accordance with law by registering the Sale Deed and/or to assign reason in writing for its non-registration within a period of one week from the date of receipt of this order. It is pertinent to mention that the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court has passed directions in the similar circumstances but the authority seems remain oblivious to such direction.



4. In view of the above, the Writ Petition stands disposed of.

A free copy of the order be supplied to the learned State Counsel for onward transmission to the authority concerned to ensure compliance.
