- 02.** 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical) Mode.
- 2.** Heard learned counsel appearing for the Parties.
- 3.** Pursuant to the order dtd.08.07.2026, learned counsel appearing for the TPCODL contended that even though an opportunity was given to all the employees facing transfer after completion of three years of service, but no objection was ever received from the Petitioner showing his difficulties if the Petitioner will be put under transfer.
- 4.** Since no objection was ever made by the Petitioner pursuant to the notice issued by the authority, Petitioner was transferred vide the impugned order dtd.30.06.2026.



4.1. It is also fairly contended that the reliever in place of the Petitioner has already joined.

5. However, considering the submission of the learned counsel appearing for the Petitioner that Petitioner be adjusted in any nearby place so that he will not place any difficulty with regard to prosecution of the study of his two minor children, learned counsel appearing for the TPCODL is directed to obtain instruction on the issue.

6. On the request made by Mr. L.K. Moharana, learned counsel appearing for the TPCODL, list this matter on 14th July, 2026.

7. Interim order passed earlier shall continue till the next date.
