1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid mode.
 2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner as well as learned counsel for the Opposite Party No.2.
 3. Although the office noting shows that notice has not been made sufficient on the Opposite Party No.2, however, since the Opposite Party No.2 is represented by her counsel, the issuance of notice to the Opposite Party No.2 is waived and the appearance of learned counsel for the Opposite Party No.2 is accepted.
 4. It is stated by the learned counsel for the Petitioner that the dispute involved in the present case has already been settled amicably and that the parties do not want to proceed further in this



case. In the aforesaid context, he referred to the settlement affidavit at Annexure-5 to the CRLMC application.

5. Learned counsel for the Opposite Party No.2 did not dispute the aforesaid submission made by the learned counsel for the Petitioner.

6. On the request of the learned counsel for the State, he is granted two weeks' time to obtain instruction from the IIC of the concerned police station with regard to the aforesaid settlement and the document at Annexure-5, list this matter in the week commencing 17.08.2026.

7. As an interim measure, it is directed that no coercive action shall be taken against the Petitioner till the next date in connection with Saintala P.S. Case No.118 of 2006, corresponding to Spl. G.R. Case No.318/47/2006/22, pending in the court of learned Addl. Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge, Titilagarh, subject to the condition that the Petitioner shall cooperate with the investigation and shall appear before the I.O. as and when his presence is required by the I.O. for the purpose of investigation and shall not harass, threaten or terrorize the Opposite Party No.2 in any manner.
