1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid mode.
 2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner. Perused the application as well as the prayer made therein.
 3. Learned counsel for the Petitioner at the outset contended that the dispute involved in the complaint case out of which the present application arises is purely commercial in nature. He further submitted that the present case has been filed as a counterblast to the complaint lodged by the Petitioner against the Informant alleging commission of an offence punishable under Section 138 of N.I. Act.
 4. Taking into consideration the nature of the dispute involved, this Court is of the prima facie view that the present dispute is a commercial dispute. In view of the aforesaid position, this Court is inclined to hear the matter further in presence of the opposite party. Hence, issue notice to the sole opposite party by Registered Post/Speed Post with A.D. by fixing a short returnable date. Requisites be filed within three working days.



5. List this matter in the week commencing 12.01.2026.

8. Accept one set of process fee.

9. As an interim measure, it is directed that on an application being filed by the Petitioner seeking stay of further proceeding in 1.C.C. Case No.6144 of 2024, the learned trial Court shall do well to adjourn the matter for a period of eight weeks.
