1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).

2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner as well as the learned Additional Government Advocate. Perused the Writ Petition as well as the documents annexed thereto.

3. The grievance of the Petitioner in the present Writ Petition is that the Petitioner Employees Union have been treated in a discriminatory manner by the Opposite Parties. To substantiate his allegation, learned counsel for the Petitioner contended that the implementation of RACP scheme in respect of Boudh Co-operative Central Bank Ltd. Employees are being treated in a discriminatory manner. On the basis of workers union belong to two different unions, two different standard have been followed although the employees belong



to same organisation. Taking into consideration this Court is of the considered view that the same is required further consideration.

4. Accordingly, issue notice to the Opposite Parties. Since Mr.Lenka, learned Additional Government Advocate accepts notice on behalf of Opposite Party No.1, soft copy of the Writ Petition, which has already been uploaded in LMS website, no hard copy is required to be served on Mr.Lenka. Soft copy of the Writ Petition, which has been uploaded in the LMS Website be utilised for the purpose of issuance of notice.

5. Notice be issued to Opposite Party No.2 by registered post with A.D. fixing a short returnable date. Requisites for issue of notice be filed within three working days.

6. List this matter in the week commencing from 01.09.2025. Counter Affidavit be filed in the meantime.
