03. 1. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioners and learned counsel for the State.

2. It appears that by order dated 11.08.2025 the learned Sessions Judge, Jajpur in BLAPL No.273 of 2025 allowed the pre-arrest bail of the Petitioner Nos.2, 4 to 6 herein namely, Maheswar Dhal @ Mahia, Kailash Chandra Nayak @ Kailash Nayak, Pramod Dhal @ Bana @ Pramod Kumar Dhal & Kakuni Dhal @ Satyajit Dhal, since it was not brought to the notice of the learned Sessions Judge,



Jajpur that the Petitioners had approached this Court in ABLAPL No.8678 of 2025 and by order dated 01.08.2025, this Court was not inclined to entertain their application for pre-arrest bail and granted liberty to the Petitioner Nos.1, 3 to 6 herein namely, Sridhar Dhal @ Kalia, Pinku Kuanra @ Ujat Kuanra, Kailash Chandra Nayak @ Kailash Nayak, Pramod Dhal @ Bana @ Pramod Kumar Dhal & Kakuni Dhal @ Satyajit Dhal respectively to move the learned Court in seisin in the first hour and in the event of rejection to move the learned Sessions Judge.

It is apt to note that so far as Petitioner No.2 (Maheswar Dhal @ Mahia) herein is concerned, this Court took note of the fact that the Investigating Agency has taken recourse to the provisions as contained in Section 35(3) of BNSS in respect of the said Petitioner No.2.

3. Since it was not placed before the learned Sessions Judge, Jajpur that the Petitioners were before this Court in ABLAPL No.8678 of 2025 including the Petitioner No.2 and they had moved the application in BLAPL No.273 of 2025 and the learned Sessions Judge by order dated 11.08.2025 granted them anticipatory bail.



4. Referring to such sharp practice adopted, the Informant has moved this Court.

5. Perused the note of the Registry at Flag-D.

6. In the considered view of this Court, it is prima facie established that brazen attempt has been made to overreach the orders passed by this Court. Hence, issue notice to the Petitioner Nos.2, 4 to 6 herein (Maheswar Dhal @ Mahia, Kailash Chandra Nayak @ Kailash Nayak, Pramod Dhal @ Bana @ Pramod Kumar Dhal & Kakuni Dhal @ Satyajit Dhal respectively) by Speed Post to submit show cause as to why proceeding should not be initiated against them for misleading the learned Sessions Judge, Jajpur.

Registry is requested to issue show cause at the address as given before the learned Sessions Judge, Jajpur.

Notice shall be served through the concerned learned Sessions Judge as well as the I.O.

Notice shall also be issued to the learned conducting counsel on behalf of the Petitioner Nos.2, 4 to 6 herein (Maheswar Dhal @ Mahia, Kailash Chandra Nayak @ Kailash Nayak, Pramod Dhal @ Bana @ Pramod Kumar Dhal & Kakuni Dhal @ Satyajit Dhal respectively) before the learned



Sessions Judge to show cause, by Speed Post, indicating the circumstances under which he moved an application without due verification.

Notice be issued to the Informant as well by Speed Post.

7. List this matter on 23.02.2026.
8. On the said date, on receipt of the show cause, further orders shall be passed.
9. Learned counsel for the State is also requested to do the needful.
