- 1.** This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.
- 2.** Heard learned counsel for appearing for the Parties.
- 3.** The present Writ Petition has been filed *inter alia* with the following prayer:-

"It is therefore, most humbly prayed that this Hon'ble Court be graciously pleased to:

i. Admit the writ application.

ii. Quash the impugned order of transfer 12.06.2026 and its consequential orders as at Annexure as at Annexure 3 & 4, being illegal, arbitrary, and unconstitutional;

Pass any other or further order(s) as may be deemed fit and proper by this Hon'ble Court in the interest of justice, equity, and fair play.

And for this act of kindness, the Petitioner, as in duty shall ever pray."

- 4.** In course of hearing, learned counsel for the Petitioner states that highlighting his grievance, Petitioner has made a representation to Opposite Party No.1 vide Annexure-5 and the same may be directed to be considered within a stipulated time, to which learned Counsel for the State has no objection.
