03. 1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. This I.A. has been filed by the petitioner under Section 5 of the Indian Limitation Act, 1963 praying for condonation of delay in preferring the second appeal vide RSA No.496 of 2025.
3. The petitioner is directed to file requisites for issuance of notices to the Opposite Parties through speed post with A.D. within seven working days.
4. As per noting of the Registry, the notices against Opposite Party Nos.3-b, 3-c, 4-c, 4-d and 8 are made sufficient on refusal. But, none has appeared on their behalf.
