1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid mode.
 2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner. Perused the application as well as documents annexed thereto.
 3. Learned counsel for the Petitioner at the outset contended that due to a misunderstanding the present case was registered at the instance of the Victim-Opposite Party No.2. He further contended that in the meantime the matter has been amicably settled. He further submitted that the statement of the Victim under Section 183 of BNSS has already been recorded.
 4. In such view of the matter, issue notice on the question of admission to the Opposite Parties.
 5. Since Mr. C.M. Singh, learned Additional Standing Counsel accepts notice on behalf of Opposite Party No.1, extra copy of the application be served on him within a week.



6. Issue notice to the Opposite Party No.2 by Registered Post with A.D. by fixing a short returnable date. Requisites be filed within three working days.

7. List this matter in the week commencing 8th September, 2025. In the meantime learned counsel for the State shall obtain the case diary in this case and obtain the statement of the Victim recorded under Section 183 of BNSS.

11. As an interim measure, it is directed that on an application being filed by the Petitioner seeking adjournment in S.T. Case No.03/52 of 2025, the same shall be adjourned for a period of four weeks.
