Heard learned counsel-Mr. Acharya appearing for the Petitioner. Very many points are advanced in support of the Petitioner's case, which merit deeper examination at the hands of this Court, more particularly, when propriety of the proceedings is also a matter for consideration.

Issue emergent notice to OPs by speed post making it returnable within two weeks, requisites for which shall be furnished within three working days.

Learned counsel- Mr. Acharya draws our attention to the application in I.A. No.12785 of 2026 supported by affidavit, wherein reprieve has been sought for.
