1. Heard Ms. K. Roy Choudhury, learned counsel for the Petitioner and Mr. M.Kumar, learned Central Government Advocate for the Opposite Parties.

2. It is submitted by both parties that the issues in present writ petition is similar to W.P.(C) No.1041 of 2026 and may be disposed of with a similar direction as passed in the other writ petition. It is further submitted on behalf of the Petitioner that his father was a genuine depositor in respect of Humara India Credit Co-operative Society Ltd. and Sahara Credit Co-operative Society Ltd. Accordingly, as per the direction dated 29th March 2023 of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India passed in I.A. No.56308 of 2023 (arising out of Writ Petition (C) No.191 of 2022), he applied before the Central Registrar of Co-operative Societies for refund of deposit amount. The same was acknowledged under Annexure-



3 dated 04.07.2024, but till date no action has been taken on the application of the Petitioner.

3. Accordingly, the writ petition is disposed of at the stage of admission with a direction to the Central Registrar, Office of CRCS, New Delhi (Opposite Party No.2) to consider the prayer of the Petitioner, in accordance with law, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order along with a copy of the writ petition.

4. An urgent certified copy of this order be granted on proper application.
