1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/ Physical Mode).
 2. Heard Mr. S.D. Das learned Sr.Counsel appearing for the Petitioners. Perused the CRLMC application as well as the prayer made therein.
 3. By filing the present CRLMC application under Section 528 of the BNSS, the Petitioners have prayed for quashing the entire criminal proceeding arising out of the Tigriria P.S. Case No. 294 of 2024 corresponding to C.T. Case No.287 of 2024 pending in the Court of the learned J.M.F.C of Tigriria, Cuttack.
 4. The learned Sr.Counsel appearing for the Petitioners at the outset contended that the Petitioners have been falsely implicated in the present CRLMC application and they are not present at the spot



of occurrence.

5. The learned counsel for the State-Opposite Party on the other hand sought for some time to obtain the case diary as well as the instruction in the matter.

6. As per the request of the learned counsel for the State-Opposite Party, he is granted four weeks' time to obtain instruction as well as the statement of the witnesses recorded in the meantime, in course of investigation and shall also obtain the copy of the charge-sheet.

7. List this matter in the week commencing 31st August, 2026.
