16. 1. The matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. Heard Mr. Ghadei, learned counsel for the Appellant and Mr. Parija, learned counsel for the Respondents.
3. We also heard the husband and wife (Appellant and Respondent No.1) are present in person.
4. It is surfaced in course of hearing that as per the direction of State Women Commission the husband namely, Ranjit Kumar Nayak has deposited a sum of Rs.15,00,000/- vide Demand Draft No.941821 dated 8th October 2021 drawn on State bank of India, Mahanadi Vihar, in favour of Chairperson Odisha State Commission for Women. It is submitted on behalf of the husband that the said amount was deposited to be paid to the wife and minor daughter. It is also submitted that said amount is lying in the account of Odisha State Commission for Women till date.



6. Accordingly, we direct the Chairperson, Odisha State Commission for Women to transfer the amount deposited vide Demand Draft No.941821 dated 8th October 2021 along with accrued interest in favour of the wife namely, Bijayalaxmi Ray towards welfare of the minor daughter namely, Raginee Ray Nayak, preferably within a period of 15 days from the date of production of certified copy of this order.
7. Copies of the Demand Draft and receipt granted by Odisha State Commission for Women are kept on record.
8. The personal appearance of the parties is dispensed with.
