1. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
2. By means of this application, the Petitioner seeks the following relief:

“Hence, it is graciously pray to allow this Writ Application in the nisi of mandamus and direct the Opposite Party No. 1 to 6 and to restore the land to the petitioners and to be directed to the Collector of Kalahandi to settled their land in the favour of the petitioner and disposed the representation application as Annexure - 7 .

And further be pleased to pass any other :order or orders as this Hon’ble court may deem fit and proper in the eye of law.”

3. Learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that for redressal of his grievance, he has submitted a representation dated 02.06.2023 (Annexure-7) before the Tahasildar, Kalahandi at Junagarh.
4. It is submitted that the aforesaid representation has not yet been disposed of by the Tahasildar.

Keeping in view the aforesaid submission of learned counsel for the Petitioner and in absence of any serious objection from learned AGA, Opposite Party No.4 (Tahasildar, Kalahandi at Junagarh) is directed to consider and dispose of the said representation in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from the date of production of a certified copy of this order and to communicate the result thereof to the Petitioner within one week thereafter.
