This matter is taken up through Hybrid arrangement (video conferencing/physical mode).

This is an application for interim bail on the ground of ailment of the wife of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the State was asked to obtain instruction on this interim application.

Today, the learned counsel for the State has produced the written instruction received from the Inspector in-charge of Raghunathpali police station from which it appears that the wife of the appellant was suffering from abnormal uterine bleeding (AUB) and Anaemia and she was referred to VIMSAR, Burla

on 15.07.2022. The written instruction is taken on record.

Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the respective parties, the averments taken in the interim application and the written instruction produced by the learned counsel for the State, I am inclined to release the petitioner on interim bail for a period of four weeks from the date of release and he shall surrender before the learned trial Court immediately on expiry of four weeks period.

For the aforesaid period, let the appellant-petitioner be released on interim bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.50,000/- (rupees fifty thousand) with two local solvent sureties each for the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court i.e. learned 1st Additional Sessions Judge, Rourkela in Sessions Trial No.03 of 2014 with further terms and conditions as the learned Court may deem just and proper subject to condition that while on interim bail, the petitioner shall not indulge in any criminal activities in any manner.

Violation of any terms and conditions shall entail cancellation of interim bail.

I.A. is accordingly disposed of.
