- 28.** 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical) Mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
3. This Interim Application has been filed seeking grant of interim bail for a period of 3(three) months for the purpose of providing treatment to his ailing mother, who is suffering from fracture of her Right Arm. In support of such suffering of his mother, reliance was placed to the document enclosed to the I.A.
4. It is contended that appellant on earlier occasion, was granted interim bail for a period of 4(four) weeks vide order dated 21.09.2022 of this Court and he surrendered on completion of interim bail period.
- 4.1. It is also contended that appellant in the meantime has undergone more than 12 years from out of the



substantive sentence of 20 years so imposed vide the impugned judgment for the offence under Section 376(D)/506/394 of the IPC.

5. Learned Addl. Govt. Advocate taking into account the seriousness of the crime and the sentence imposed, opposed the prayer for Interim Bail.

6. Having heard learned counsel for the parties, considering the submission made and since appellant on the earlier occasion has been allowed interim bail vide order dated 21.09.2022 and appellant's presence is required for treatment of his ailing mother, this Court is inclined to direct for release of the appellant on interim bail for a period of 2(two) months to be counted from the date of his release, on such terms and conditions as deem fit and proper to be imposed by the learned Court in seisin in Session Trial No.03 of 2014 in the file of learned 1st Addl. Sessions Judge, Rourkela.

6.1. It is however observed that the appellant shall surrender immediately after completion of the interim bail period without fail.

7. I.A. stands disposed of.
