1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
 2. Mr. Bikram Chandra Ghadei, learned counsel being authorized by Mr. Amiya Ranjan Sethy, learned counsel for the Petitioner reiterated the submission in the writ petition.
 3. Mr. Swayambhu Mishra, learned Additional Standing Counsel on instruction submits that the Petitioner playing fraud with her mother namely Haramani Sahoo, had received the entire compensation amount. The said Haramani Sahoo has also filed a suit for partition, declaration and permanent injunction. Suppressing that fact the Petitioner received the entire compensation amount. Hence, the Collector directed the Petitioner to refund the compensation amount he has received and lodged FIR against him. Though the amount received by the Petitioner, has been deposited, but the question of entitlement/apportionment of the compensation is in dispute.



4. Hence, the prayer in the writ petition cannot be granted. He however prays for an adjournment to file a detailed affidavit stating the facts.
