01. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners. Perused the application as well as prayer made therein.
3. By filing the present application under Section 528 of the B.N.S.S. which corresponds to 482 of Cr.P.C. the Petitioners seeks for quashing the entire criminal proceeding arising out of G.R. case No.345 of 2023 for commission of offence under Sections 363 I.P.C. and now pending before the learned S.D.J.M., Khurda.
4. Learned counsel for the Petitioners further contended that in the meantime the Petitioners and the Opposite Party No.2- informant have married and in support of such contention, also referred to the



marriage certificate.

5. Issue notice on the question of admission to the Opposite Parties.
6. Learned Additional Standing Counsel accepts notice on behalf of the Opposite Party No.1, extra copy of the application be served on him within three working days.
7. Issue notice to the Opposite Party No.2 by Registered Post with A.D. by fixing a short returnable date. Requisites be filed within three working days.
8. As prayed for by the learned counsel for the State, he is granted two weeks' time to obtain instruction in the matter.
9. List this matter in the week commencing from 15th September, 2025.
