12. This matter is taken up through Hybrid arrangement (video conferencing/physical mode).

This is an application for bail.

Perused the report of the learned trial Court which indicates that the victim has been paid the compensation amount of Rs.7,00,000/-, out of the recommendation amount of Rs.8,00,000/- by the learned trial Court.

Immediate steps shall be taken for payment of the balance amount and compliance report to be submitted before this Court by the next date.

Learned counsel for the petitioner drew the attention of this Court to the evidence of P.W.20, the



doctor, who examined the victim on 10.01.2021 on police requisition and in the cross-examination, the doctor has stated that the victim was not pregnant at the time of her examination. However, learned counsel for the State submits that the medical report, which has been marked by the said doctor (P.W.20) as Ext.P2, *inter alia*, indicates that the victim girl was pregnant. Therefore, inadvertently, the doctor has stated that victim girl was not pregnant at the time of examination.

Be that as it may, let the learned counsel for the State produce the birth certificate of the child of the victim on the next date.

The file be placed before the learned Registrar (Judicial) to communicate the order to the learned trial court.

Put up this matter in the week commencing from 24th November, 2025.
