11. This matter is taken up through Hybrid arrangement (video conferencing/physical mode).

This is an application for bail.

Learned counsel for the informant submits that she has taken instruction that on account of the incident in question, not only the victim became pregnant but she has delivered a baby girl and now she is staying at her father's house.

Learned counsel for the State shall obtain instruction about the status of the victim as well as her child.



Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he also may be given some time to obtain certain instruction in this matter.

In the impugned judgment, learned Additional District & Sessions Judge-cum-Special Court under POCSO Act, Nabarangpur has recommended the case of the victim to the DLSA, Nabarangpur for payment of compensation of Rs.8,00,000/-.

Learned counsel appearing for the informant submits that the victim has received Rs.7,00,000/- only.

Let a report be called for from the learned trial Court as to whether the compensation amount of Rs.8,00,000/- has been paid to the victim or not and if so, the documentary proof in respect of such payment shall also be forwarded to this Court with the report.

The file be placed before the Registrar (Judicial) to communicate this order to the learned trial Court.
