1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.
2. Sri Pradipta Kumar Mohanty, Senior Advocate enters appearance on behalf of the Intervener-Petitioner in the present case by filing a memorandum in court today and the same be kept on record.
3. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioners as well as Mr.P.K.Mohanty, learned Senior Counsel appearing for the Interveners-Petitioners.
4. Although the present CMP application was disposed of vide order dated 05.05.2026 thereby directing the learned trial court to make every endeavour to conclude the suit within a period of one year, however, such order was passed without issuing notice to the Opposite Parties. It also appears that the Interveners-Petitioners in



I.A No.1174 of 2026 were not parties to the suit as well as to the CMP application. In view of the order passed today in CMP No.1958 of 2025, this Court has already allowed the Interveners-Petitioners to be impleaded as parties to the suit. Therefore, the application for intervention stands allowed.

5. Since in CMP No.1958 of 2025, the application of the Petitioners to implead as parties to the suit has already been allowed and in the present CMP there is a direction to dispose of the suit as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of one year, no further order is required to be passed in the present CMP application.

6. Accordingly, the I.A stands disposed of.
