1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid mode.
 2. Heard Mr. B.A. Mahanti, learned senior counsel along with Ms. Mamta Tripathy, learned counsel for the Petitioners. Perused the application as well as the prayer made therein.
 3. The present application has been filed under Section 528 of BNSS seeking quashing of the FIR No.644 dated 20.12.2024 on the ground that the dispute involved in the FIR is commercial in nature.
 4. Learned senior counsel at the outset contended that in the present criminal proceeding the Informant is advancing a commercial dispute.
 5. In such view of the matter, issue notice to the Opposite Parties.
 6. Since Mr. S.K.Parhi, learned Additional Standing Counsel accepts notice on behalf of Opposite Party No.1, extra copy of the



application be served on him within a week.

7. Issue notice to the Opposite Party No.2 by Registered Post/Speed Post with A.D. by fixing a short returnable date. Requisites be filed within three working days.

8. List this matter along with CRLMC No.3081 of 2025 on 10.11.2025.

9. This I.A. has been filed by the Petitioners with a prayer to dispense with the certified copy of the FIR under Annexure-5 for the time being.

10. Heard.

11. Considering the prayer made by the learned counsel for the Petitioners and the ground stated in the application the filing of the certified copy of the FIR at Annexure-5 is dispensed with for the time being.

12. Accordingly, the I.A. stands disposed of.
