- 1.** The appellant-wife is before this Court challenging the judgment and decree dated 08.07.2025 passed in MAT Case No.57 of 2023 by the learned Senior Civil Judge, Athagarh, thereby allowing the petition filed by the appellant-wife under Section 13(i)(i-a)(i-b) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, decreeing the dissolution of marriage held on 04.03.2022.
 - 2.** It is submitted by the learned counsel for the appellant and the appellant is only challenging the quantum of alimony granted i.e. Rs.3,00,000/- (Rupees Three Lakh) only. It is stated that the amount granted is too frugal, considering the cost of living today.
 - 3.** Issue notice on admission by Speed/Registered Post with A.D.

Requisites for issuance of notice to the respondent shall be filed within five working days, early returnable date may be fixed.
