- 16.** 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical) Mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
3. In course of hearing, when Mr. D.P. Nanda, learned Senior Counsel appearing for Opp. Party No.5 contended that on the face of opportunity being given, petitioner is not reporting to discharge his duty, learned counsel for the petitioner contended that in terms of letter issued on 20.07.2024 by Opp. Party No.6, petitioner is ready and willing to join in his work.
- 3.1. It is also fairly contended that petitioner will report for duty without fail on 11.02.2026.
