1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical Mode).
2. Since the appellant has already filed the cheque of Rs.25,000/- towards the statutory deposit, the cheque amount be invested in the name of Registrar (Judicial) in any Nationalized Bank by opening an interest bearing account renewable from time to time.
3. On the prayer of the learned counsel for the appellant, four weeks time is allowed for payment of deficit Court fees. Accordingly, IA No.2043 of 2025 stands disposed of.
4. It is however, informed at the bar that the Respondent-Claimant No.1 has in fact expired in the meantime after passing of the award and therefore, the insurer is, hereby, directed to take proper steps in the matter.
