1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid mode.
2. This interlocutory application has been filed by the Petitioner in a disposed of CRLMC application with a prayer to direct the learned trial court to comply with the order dated 09.12.2025 passed by this Court in the above noted CRLMC application within a stipulated period of time
3. Learned counsel for the Petitioner, at the outset, contended that the CRLMC application was initially disposed of vide order dated 09.12.2025 with a direction to the learned trial court to examine the I.O. within period of six weeks. Learned counsel for the Petitioner, at this juncture, alleged that despite such clear direction, the I.O. has not been examined as of now. As such, it is



alleged violation of this Court's order.

4. In view of the aforesaid allegation, the registry is directed to call for a report from the learned Special Judge (Vigilance), Balasore in T.R. No.28 of 2011, which arises out of Balasore Vigilance P.S. Case No.53 of 2025. The report should reach this Court by 24th April, 2026 positively.
