- 02.** 1. Mr. D. Mund, learned counsel has entered appearance on behalf of the Opposite Party No.2 by filing Vaklatanama in Court. The same is taken on record. The name of D. Mund, learned counsel and his associates be reflected in the file, cause list as well as CMS of this Court.
2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned counsel for the Opposite Parties.
3. During the course of hearing, it is submitted by the learned counsel for the Petitioner as well as Opposite Party, on instruction, that that their clients are agreeable to explore the possibility of settlement of the matter through ADR by way of Mediation.
